CHARGING POLICY:

Our charging policy relating to all legal services offered, which includes, but is not limited to: commercial litigation including (counter-fraud, and counter-corruption), business fraud and investigations, contentious probate, reputation management, divorce/finance, child law, and mediation services, are set out below.

Our approach to fees generally is to be open, transparent, and accountable regarding the fees you will pay.

We will communicate with you as a client from the outset and discuss other available funding options, such as cover under an insurance policy.

We do not, as a general rule, take on conditional fee agreements.

We do not hold a public legal funding/legal aid franchise and cannot therefore take on work on that basis.

Depending on the case or matter in question, there may be additional disbursements.

Disbursements in respect of the work we do, generally means court fees. A list of the current court fees is found in the following link: [Civil court fees \(EX50\) - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/civil-court-fees-ex50) This link is correct with effect from 1st May 2024.

Disbursements can also be the costs of using a barrister from time to time, and instruction of expert valuers, expert actuaries and accountants in pensions, etc...It can also be the costs of a mediator, or arbitrator. These figures are usually negotiated and agreed in advance by us, and agreed with you, before those fees are in turn agreed.

Our retainer letter with you will state the breakdown of our hourly rates charged in units of 6 minutes per hour (i.e., 5 units = 30 minutes), being the industry-accepted norm. It will also state any likely disbursements which may arise.

As a client you will receive regular information about costs and fees when appropriate and in any event at regular times.

You will also receive, once available, a costs/risks analysis.

We will endeavour to provide you with a general overall costs view, if a case were to go to a final hearing, where appropriate.
